Purpose

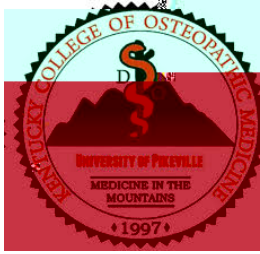
University of Pikeville – Kentucky College of Osteopathic Medicine (KYCOM) adheres to this policy regarding the transfer of students. KYCOM may only accept transfer credits from a school accredited by the Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation (COCA) or Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME), where the student is eligible for readmission. In addition, all transfer students must acquire osteopathic manipulative medicine (OMM)/osteopathic principles and practice (OPP) competency prior to graduation. The last two (2) years of the transfer student’s medical education must also be completed at KYCOM.
