<u>Purpose</u>

University of Pikeville - Kentucky College of Osteopathic Medicine (KYCOM) provides its students, faculty, and staff with confidential access to an effective system of professional mental health care and support. Access to mental health services must be accessible 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, from all locations where students receive their education from KYCOM.



Individual, couples, and group counseling, as well as referral and consultation services. All services are provided free of charge to UPIKE-KYCOM students, faculty, and staff. Typical counseling sessions usually last between 45-60 minutes. Special sessions may be scheduled on an as-needed basis, as recommended by the counselor.
